DESCRIPTION: Rick Florio, Manager-Technical Building Solutions-Pentair | Ken Baird, Vice President, Systems Design - LRI Engineering Inc. The seminar will focus on topics surrounding the protection of life safety systems serving complex buildings. This includes buildings considered "High Buildings" in the Ontario Building Code and those that contain interconnected floor spaces.

These spaces require the protection of electrical conductors for fire alarm, smoke management and emergency power systems. Design and implementation challenges for new construction and retrofit of existing facilities will be discussed. The seminar will include a close look at "Electrical Life Safety Circuits" that require fire protection or the application of CAN/ULC S139 "Standard Method of Fire Test for Evaluation of Integrity of Electrical Power, Data and Optical Fibre Cables". Important information regarding an update to the 2012 de-certification of "Listed Fire

Resistive Cables" will also be provided.
