DESCRIPTION: Kate Reinhart, Keirsten Swim, Sandra Ausma and Samantha Jefferis - Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry. This presentation will explain some of the recent changes to the Public Lands Act and associated regulations that came into effect in June, 2017, including what is "free use". Plus, when MNRF work permits are needed, best practices for shoreline work, 2-storey boathouse process, land tenure and more.
