Responsible for:

Reporting to the Supervisor of Zoning Services the Zoning Plans Examiner II is responsible for examining and analyzing Site Plan and Architectural drawings and documentation including property surveys, specifications, site statistical data, calculations and reports submitted for building permits, development applications and Zoning approvals for the administration, enforcement and determination of compliance with applicable Zoning By-Laws (past and present), related regulations, and applicable laws for the purposes of issuing building permits and supporting development approvals. Responsible for the delivery of the Zoning Services Section's front line customer service with respect to front-counter (in-person), email and telephone inquiries. Provides technical assistance/expertise and Zoning By-law interpretations for verbal and written responses to the public, developers, builders, design professionals, internal and external City departments, Regional, Provincial and Federal agencies and departments, City and Regional Councilors, external groups and organizations, key stakeholders, business and legal professionals, etc. and liaises where appropriate. Provides comments to various departments regarding Committee of Adjustments applications, draft Zoning By-Laws and By-Law Amendments, Site Plan Applications, draft Plans of Subdivisions, Condominium Plans and Part-lot Control Exemptions. Performs complex calculations and makes analytical assessments to determine compliance with Zoning By-law provisions. Researches and prepares reports with regards to development proposals and performs site inspections as required. Represents the Building Standards Department as a Zoning Subject Matter Expert at various committees and meetings including Committee of Adjustment, Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) and in court proceedings, as required.
